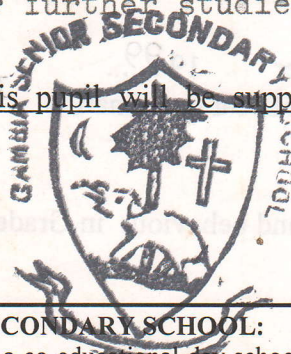

NOTE ON GAMBIA SENIOR SECONDARY SCHOOL:

Gambia Senior Secondary School is a co-educational day school with an independent Board of Governors, grant-aided by the government of the Gambia. All subjects except woodwork, metalwork, and Physical education are taught by University Graduates. The medium of instruction is English. Students take a 3 year course leading to the Senior School Certificate Examination of the West African Examination Council. This public exam, is internationally recognised as being the equivalent of the G.C.S.E. in UK and in other Commonwealth countries. The Exam result is expressed, subject by subject, on a 9 grade scale: grade F9 is failure; grade E8 and D7 are low-level passes; grade C6 - A1 indicate a good achievement and are used for entry to higher education and for responsible employment. Some pupils go beyond W.A.S.S.C.E. to the University where they take 4 year degree courses. All Universities within the West African sub-region recognise this Examination as an Entry requirement.
