I have no doubt that if given the chance, he can perform to the best of his ability. I highly recommend him to any institution so as to further his nursing education.

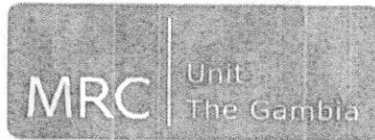

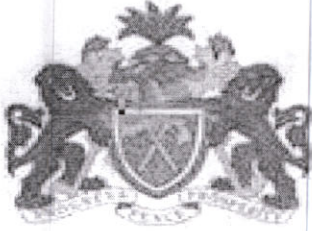
