NOTE ON MINGDAW JUNIOR/SENIOR SECONDARY SCHOOL

Mingdaw Junior/Senior Secondary School is a co-educational school established in 1997 by the Mingdaw Cultural Centre in Taiwan. Though run by a Board of Governors set up by The Gambia Government, the school continues to benefit from Non-Governmental Organisations in the Republic of China. At the end of the 9th grade students take the Gambia Junior Secondary School Certificate Examinations and at the end of Grade 12 the West African Senior School Certificate Examinations in both Arts and Commerce. The medium of instruction is English. The public exam, is internationally recognized as being the equivalent of the G.C.S.E in UK and in other Commonwealth countries. The Exam result is expressed, subject-by-subject, on a 9-grade scale: grade F9 is failure; grade E8 and D7 are low-level passes, grade C6 – A1 indicate a good achievement and are used for entry too higher education and for responsible employment. Some pupils go beyond W.A.S.S.C.E to the University where they take 4-year degree course. All Universities within the West African sub-region recognize this Examination as an Entry requirement.
